Board Meeting Minutes

3 November 2014

The meeting was called to order at 6:45 PM by President, Judy Uelmen at the Bioscience Bldg. of Gateway Technical College.

The Secretary's minutes were read and approved.

Judy Uelmen said that Judy Reynolds has been doing a very nice job of updating the KCGS Facebook page for publicity.

The KCGS Holiday party will be held the 2nd Monday of December at the Madrigano Auditorium at Gateway Technical College. This will take the place of the December meeting. The party is for paid members and spouses/partners.

Judy Uelmen said that she had attended a Rotary Club lunch and gave a presentation as a representative of KCGS.

The Treasurer's report was read and approved. Frank reported that we have 39 paid memberships. Frank also reported that he had sent in the membership dues of KCGS to the WI State Genealogy Society.

KCGS will have the display case at the Northside Library for the month of December. Suzanne is working on getting the theme and ideas together for the display. She will ask for assistance at the November general meeting.

Judy Uelmen mentioned that KCGS has been having some problems with the *Kenosha News* concerning publicity not appearing in the paper.

It was brought up that the KCGS dues might have to be increased from \$10 to \$15 per year. This will have to be put to a vote of the general membership. It will be discussed at the January 2015 general meeting.

Mary Ann brought up the issue of a lot of research being done for non-members who contact KCGS thru the web-site. Currently we only ask for a donation for research and most people do not respond to the request. The web-site should be updated to reflect the charges for research. Mary Ann will send Judy an update to be added to the web-site for research charges.
